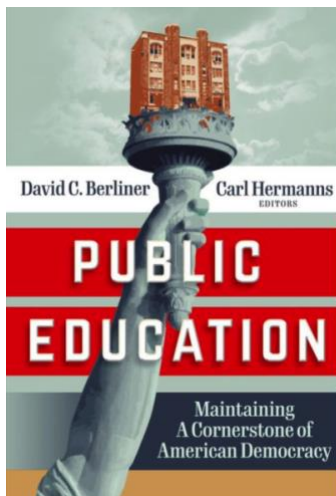

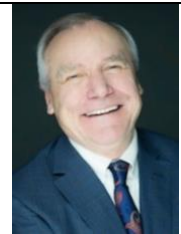
The 2022 Outstanding Friend of Education Award will be presented to Valerie Strauss, Education Editor of the Washington Post.

Education: Bachelor's degree: University of Miami. Master's degree: Northwestern University
Valerie Strauss covers education and runs The Washington Post's long-running Answer Sheet blog. She sees the education beat broadly and writes about the practice, politics, sociology, and psychology and it. , She came to the Post as an assistant foreign editor for Asia in 1987 and worked as a weekend foreign desk editor during some of the most riveting moments in modern times, including the 1989 Tiananmen Square protests in China and the collapse of the Soviet empire. She led award-winning projects on the Cultural Revolution and the plight of women in third-world countries. She came to the Post from Reuters, where she worked as the national security editor and a military/foreign affairs reporter on Capitol Hill.



The 2022 Outstanding Public Educator Award will be presented to Gloria Ladson Billings, Professor, U. of Wisconsin.

Professor Emerita, former Kellner Family Distinguished Professor in Urban Education in the Department of Curriculum & Instruction, and former Faculty Affiliate in the Departments of Educational Policy Studies, Educational Leadership & Policy Analysis, and Afro American Studies at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. She also is the current President of the National Academy of Education and a Fellow in the American Academy of Arts & Sciences. Ladson-Billings' research examines the pedagogical practices of teachers who are successful with African American students. She also investigates Critical Race Theory applications to education. She is a former president (2005-2006) of the American Educational Research Association and former editor of the American Educational Research Journal.

The 2022 Friend of the League Award will be presented to **James Harvey**, current president of the League. Dr. Harvey was instrumental in bringing together Christy Johnson and her company, Artemis Connection, to facilitate the strategic planning process for the League's future development. Jim is also the Executive Director of the National Superintendents Roundtable and was also lead writer of the 1983 "Nation at Risk" publication about the public schools.

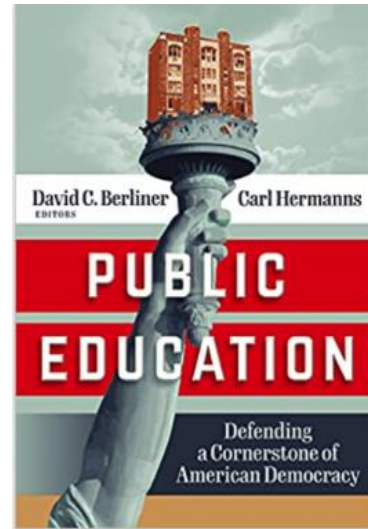

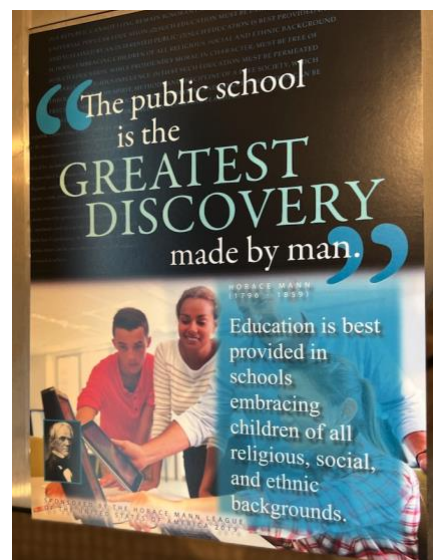
